- One of Israel's largest renewable energy companies.
- Headquartered in Ramat-Gan, Israel.
- Active in Israel, Poland, and the U.S.
- Market cap approximately \$1.9 billion.
- Publicly traded company on the Tel Aviv stock exchange since May 2011.


The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) has prepared the present report pursuant to Human Rights Council resolution 31/36 on Israeli settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, and in the occupied Syrian Colan.

Owned the "Meitarim Solar Field" in occupied West Bank from 2015-2020.

Designated as "Category G" business by Office of the U.N. High Commissioner for Human Rights.

- Developed 155 MW field of wind turbines in occupied Syrian Golan Heights in 2015.
- Partnered with Israel Defense
 Ministry to build 41 wind turbines.

How does Energix exercise undue influence within Virginia state government?

- Energix is promoted by the Virginia Israel Advisory Board (VIAB).
- VIAB is a state agency under the General Assembly of Virginia funded by Virginia taxpayers that advocates exclusively for Israeli businesses.
- Energix, through VIAB, has access to legislators that homegrown Virginia businesses, including solar energy companies, do not have.





How does Energix exercise undue influence within Virginia state government?

- VIAB connects Energix with senior political leaders in Virginia.
- VIAB sponsored a trade delegation to Israel in 2019 in which former Gov. Northam and former Secretary of Commerce and Trade Brian Ball met with Energix officials.

What undue subsidies does Energix extract from state and federal sources?

- In 2020, Energix received a Virginia Jobs Investment Program subsidy that supported Energix's human resources costs.
- In 2020, Energix received a third of all the state's PPP forgivable loans in the category of industrial scale solar projects although Energix was flush with cash from overseas stock sales and only employed several full-time employees.





The Plaintiffs identified above move this court for declaratory judgment against the Defendants herein, and in support thereof state as follows:

I. Basis for Jurisdiction
